He was a Great Healer, and now we will have N.A.Navajo Sweat Lodges again at our Gathering in September. There will be limited numbers, so book early.

Another New Member to our Kupidabin Family. Terry Saleh, aka Kunge, has been a long-time friend of Des and myself (18 years) and always was and is a strong supporter of Kupidabin. He is a renowned Australian Artist and welcomed in many countries of the world, especially in the Native American Community, which is a regular destination when Ceremonies are being held, etc.

Terry has a strong interest in Indigenous People around the World and known as a "Spiritual Elder Artist and Healer
